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Sunder has brought girls from Kapasheda, Haryana, Loni, Khajuri Khas, Ghaziabad, Saibabad, Meerut, Muzaffar Nagar, Gorakhpur in Uttar Pradesh. "Some women are widows while some have marital disputes and all of them need quick money. They get Rs. 20,000 while I get Rs. 5,000," he said.

A donor from Loni, Najma, carrying an injection tied with a cold pack in her hands, present at the clinic nodded her head in agreement. "This is my second

time. I have one child and my husband usually goes to neighbouring States for work but due to his health issues we are suffering from monetary issues," said Najma.

"Four days after injection, I meet the doctor for an ultrasound and after another four days my peak up time comes. I am given anesthesia and send back in four to five hours," said Najma.

Butola, who is also the chairperson of the Centre for the Study of Regional Development at Jawaharlal Nehru University

(JNU), said, "Surrogate mothers are not supposed to conceive more than three times, but now six to eight times is very common. She is supposed to have only one baby but generally to avoid a risk, doctors put five eggs in a surrogate mothers body without her knowledge and this is where the commerce of women ova comes in the play."

Butola, who is committed to maintain the privacy of the egg donors, said surrogacy is so exploitative that doctor and middle men make 60 per cent of the money from the commissioning parents. "In Delhi, girls are given from Rs 20,000 to Rs 80,000. Rates depend on the looks of the girl."
